Station F, Catlins Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to Trig. Station Z, Wisp Hill; thence north-easterly along a right line to Trig. Station O on the southern boundary of Block VIII, Warepa Survey District; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Sections 8 and 9, Block VIII, Warepa Survey District, and northerly along the western boundary of Section 9 aforesaid and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Owaka River; thence generally south-easterly down the middle of that river to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Run 517, Warepa Survey District; thence northerly to and along that boundary to the middle of the Puerua River; thence generally easterly down the middle of that river to the north-western boundary of Section 1, Block IX, Warepa Survey District; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of that section to the north-western side of the little Puerua Road; thence generally south-westerly along the north-western side of that road to the northern boundary of Block III, Catlins Survey District; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of that Block III to the north-western corner of Section 53, Block IX, Glenomaru Survey District; thence south-easterly and southerly along the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of that Section 53 to the north-western corner of Section 54, Block IX aforesaid; thence easterly, southerly, and south-westerly along the northern, eastern, and south-eastern boundaries of that section to a point in line with the northern boundary of Section 58, Block IX aforesaid; thence easterly to and along that boundary and southerly along the eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section to the north-western corner of Section 25, Block IX aforesaid; thence easterly along the northern boundaries of Section 25, Block IX aforesaid, and Section 47, Block III, Glenomaru Survey District, and southerly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 47 and 50, Block III aforesaid, to the north-eastern corner of Section 45, Block IX, Glenomaru Survey District; thence again southerly and easterly along the eastern and northern boundaries of that Section 45 to the north-western corner of Section 32, Block VII, Glenomaru Survey District; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of that Section 32 to its south-eastern corner; thence generally north-easterly along the south-eastern side of the road intersection, Section 8, to the western boundary of the Catlins River Branch Railway; thence south-easterly along a right line to the western boundary of the land shown on D.P. 2692; thence generally south-easterly along the generally south-western boundary of the land shown on D.P. 2692 to its southernmost corner; thence south-easterly along a right line to the northernmost corner of Section 31, Block VII, Glenomaru Survey District; thence generally south-easterly along the generally south-western side of Jones Road to the north-eastern corner of Section 37, Block VIII, Glenomaru Survey District; thence south-easterly and southerly along the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of Section 37 aforesaid and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the north-western corner of Section 13, Block V, Glenomaru Survey District; thence easterly along the northern boundary of that Section 13 and generally south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 13 and 25, Block V aforesaid, to a point due west of the southernmost corner of Section 31, Block V, Glenomaru Survey District; thence due east to the southernmost corner of that Section 31; thence south-easterly along a right line to the source of the stream flowing into the ocean at Tucks Bay, shown on S.O. Plan 528; thence south-easterly down the middle of that stream to the sea coast; thence generally south-westerly along the sea coast to a point in line with the north-western side of the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section 1b, Block IX, Tautuku Survey District; thence generally north-easterly to and along the north-western side of that road and its production to the middle of the Tautuku River; thence generally north-westerly up the middle of the Tautuku River to a point in line with the middle of the Fleming River; thence generally north-

easterly to and up the middle of the Fleming River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Section 39, Block VII, Tautuku Survey District; thence north-easterly along a right line to the south-western corner of Section 39 aforesaid; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Sections 39 and 38, Block VII aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of Section 38 aforesaid; thence north-easterly along a right line to the southernmost corner of Section 7, Block VIII aforesaid; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of that Section 7 and Section 31, Block IV, Tautuku Survey District, to the easternmost corner of that Section 31; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern side of a road to the road angle opposite the easternmost corner of Section 17, Block IV aforesaid; thence north-westerly along a right line to that easternmost corner of Section 17 aforesaid; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Section 16, Block IV aforesaid, and Sections 12, 11, and 10, Block III, Tautuku Survey District, to the westernmost corner of that last-mentioned section; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Section 10 to the southernmost corner of Section 9, Block III aforesaid; thence north-westerly and north-easterly along the south-western and north-western boundaries of Section 9 aforesaid to the north-eastern corner of Section 25, Block III aforesaid; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 25 aforesaid and its production to the generally eastern boundary of Section 1, Block II, Tautuku Survey District; thence generally southerly along the eastern boundary of that Section 1 and north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of that section and Section 2, Block II aforesaid, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the southernmost corner of Lot 2, D.P. 3052; thence generally north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, D.P. 3052, and Section 5, Block II aforesaid, to the westernmost corner of Section 5; thence north-westerly to and along the south-western boundary of Section 14, Block I, Tautuku Survey District, and north-easterly along the north-western boundary of that section and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Tahakopa River; thence generally north-westerly up the middle of that river to the eastern boundary of Block X, Rimu Survey District; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Block X and westerly and northerly along the southern and western boundaries of that block to the point of commencement.

All that area in the Owaka Rabbit District containing 62,600 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at Trig. Station Z, Wisp Hill, Catlins Survey District, and proceeding generally north-easterly and south-easterly along the generally north-western and north-eastern boundaries of the Owaka Rabbit District, hereinbefore described, to the sea coast at Tucks Bay, Glenomaru Survey District; thence generally south-westerly along the sea coast to the middle of the mouth of the Catlins River; thence generally north-westerly up the middle of the Catlins River to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Chloris Pass Road; thence generally north-westerly along the generally south-western boundary of the Owaka Rabbit District to the point of commencement.

All that area in the Owaka Rabbit District containing 69,200 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the north-western corner of Block X, Rimu Survey District, and proceeding generally easterly and northerly along the northern and western boundaries of the Owaka Rabbit District, hereinbefore described, to the middle of the Catlins River; thence generally south-easterly down the middle of that river to the sea coast; thence generally south-westerly and north-westerly along the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of the Owaka Rabbit District Boundary, hereinbefore described, to the point of commencement.
