## SCHEDULE

C.A.V. dual sealed-beam apparatus consisting of two units, each unit incorporating two headlamps embossed with the symbols "1A" and "2A" respectively, and having a lens diameter of 5\frac{2}{3} in. When in use all four headlamps shall be illuminated to provide the main beams, and the two headlamps embossed with the symbols "2A" shall be illuminated to provide the dipped beams.
