A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 29 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1948, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the access way described in the First Schedule hereto, subject to the building-line restriction contained in K.77336, North Auckland Land Registry, is hereby closed and added to the land now held for a public school described in the Second Schedule hereto.
