RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Commercial Development Loan No. 3, 1962

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Northcote Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of eighteen thousand pounds (£18,000) authorised to be raised by the Northcote Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of developing Northcote shopping centre and industrial areas and releasing deferred payment licence on land, the said Northcote Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of two-tenths of one penny (0.2d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Northcote, comprising the whole of the Borough of Northcote; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 7th day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
