ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of January 1963

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby sets apart the Maori freehold land described in the Schedule hereto as a Maori reservation for the purpose of a meeting place and sports recreation ground for the common use and benefit of the residents of Kennedy's Bay.
