Prices for Butter and Cheese Intended for Export

PURSUANT to the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act PURSUANT to the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act 1961, the Dairy Products Prices Authority has fixed the prices to be paid for all butter and cheese manufactured from milk or cream delivered to a dairy factory in the season commencing on the 1st day of June 1963, and acquired by the New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board, pursuant to Part II of the said Act, at the several prices and upon the terms, stipulations, and conditions following, that is to say:

 (f) For "Third" grade, the price of 23.614d. per pound: 2. In the case of whey butter to which is assigned one or other of the following grades under the said regulations—
 - (a) For "First" grade, the price of 27.614d. per pound:
- (b) For "Second" grade, the price of 27.114d. per pound: 3. In the case of New Zealand waxed cheddar cheese to which is assigned one or other of the following respective grades and which is allotted points in grading within the range of the following respective grade points under the said regulations-
 - (a) For "Finest" grade, 94 points or over, the price of 19.334d. per pound:
 - (b) For "Finest" grade, 93 points or over but under 94 points, the price of 19.084d. per pound:

- (c) For "First" grade, 92 points or over but under 93 points, the basic price of 18.084d. per pound:

4. In the appropriate cases there shall be deducted from the prices fixed in paragraph 3 hereof the following amounts where cheese finish points have been deducted in the Grader's Certificate:

- point deduction 1s. 8d. per crate.
 point deduction 2s. 6d. per crate.
 points deduction 4s. 2d. per crate.
 points deduction 6s. 8d. per crate.
- $2\frac{1}{2}$ points deduction 10s. per crate.

5. In the appropriate cases the following amounts shall be added to or deducted from the prices fixed in paragraph 3 hereof where cheese has been classified by the Department of Agriculture in respect of cheese sediment test:

Classification A-an addition of 0.125d. per pound.

Classification B - no alteration.

Classification C-a deduction of 0.0625d. per pound.

Classification D-a deduction of 0.125d. per pound.

6. Butter shall be packed in boxes each containing a net weight of 56 lb 2 oz of actual butter, excluding wrapping paper. Cheese shall be packed two cheeses to each crate. Every cheese shall weigh not less than 70 lb and not more than 90 lb.

7. In computing the weight of butter for which payment is to be made by the Board the weight of all butter comprised in any consignment submitted for grading under the said regulations shall be ascertained as follows:

(a) Each box of butter containing a net weight of 56 lb 2 oz of actual butter, excluding wrapping paper, shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be computed at 56 lb:
