PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Whangarei Borough Council Electric Lines Licence 1963.

2. Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the Whangarei Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the licensee") is hereby authorised to lay, construct, put up, place, and use electric lines within the area described in the Schedule

hereto.

3. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.

4. The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the licensee with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, the Radio Interference Regulations 1958, and with all regulations made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this

licence. Provided that the licensee shall not, by virtue of this clause, be required, except in the course of alteration, repair, or maintenance, to reconstruct in conformity with the regulations hereinbefore mentioned any electric lines or works which conformed to the regulations in force at the time of

which conformed to the regulations in force at the time of the construction thereof.

5. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (d), (e), (f) and (h), of regulation 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.

6. This licence shall, unless it is sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 31st day of March 1984.

7. The Order in Council dated the 6th day of December 1949, and published in the Gazette on the 8th day of the same month at page 2777, authorising the licensee to erect and use certain electric lines is hereby revoked.
