PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Christchurch City Council Electric Lines Licence 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch City Council Electric Lines Licence 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. The principal order is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph to the First Schedule thereto:

"3. Underground cables for the transmission of electrical energy commencing at the New Zealand Electricity Department's Addington substation in the Borough of Riccarton and proceeding along Princess Street, across Clarence Street, along Foster Street, and along Lowe Street to Deans Avenue, the route of the said cables being shown by means of a red line on the plan marked N.Z.E.D. 614 deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington."
