

HAWKE'S BAY ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hawke's Bay Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purposes of providing the annual charges on a loan of two hundred and fifty thousand pounds (£250,000) authorised to be raised by the Hawke's Bay Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of further reticulating the Board's district (excluding the Borough of Napier as constituted on the 6th day of July 1925) and increasing the capacity of existing lines, the said Hawke's Bay Electric Power Board hereby make a special rate of seventeen-two hundredths (17/200ths) of a penny (d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property within the constituent districts of the County of Hawke's Bay, the Boroughs of Havelock North and Taradale, the City of Hastings, and within that portion of the City of Napier as at present constituted which on the 6th day of July 1925 was included in the County of Hawke's Bay; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twelve (12) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
