Crown Land or State Housing Land Set Apart for the Purposes of the Maori Housing Act 1935

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Maori Housing Amendment Act 1938, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Proclamation dated the 24th day of June 1963 and published in the Gazette on the 4th day of July 1963 at page 905 declaring certain State housing land within the meaning of the Housing Act 1955 to be set apart for the purposes of the Maori Housing Act 1935 be amended by substituting for the description of land in the First Schedule hereto the description of land in a Second Schedule hereto.
