RESOLUTION PLEDGING SPECIAL RATE

Renewal Loan 1963, £15,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Napier City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £15,000 (fifteen thousand pounds) authorised to be raised by the Napier City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity those portions of the General Works Loan 1950, Marewa Streets Loan 1951, and Streets Loan 1950, which mature on 1 December 1963, the said Napier City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought six two (0.062) of a penny (d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the City of Napier; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 15th day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
