SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

3. The system of supply shall be as described in paragraph (d) of regulation 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and shall be an alternating current system at a normal rated pressure of 230 V.

DURATION OF LICENCE

4. Unless sooner lawfully determined this licence shall con-tinue in force until the 31st day of March 1984.

Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth the Waite-mata Electric Power Board (hereinafter referred to as the licensee) is hereby authorised to lay, construct, put up, place, and use electric lines and to construct the electric works described in the Schedule hereto. 2. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as they may be incon-sistent with the provisions of this licence. 3. The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, the Radio Interference Regulations 1958, and with all regulations made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.
