Fire Appliance Loan 1962 of £4,700

THE following resolution was duly passed at a special meeting of the Henderson Borough Council held on the 30th day of January 1963:

"Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Henderson Borough Council hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on the loan of £4,700 authorised to be raised by the Henderson Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing a new fire appliance, the said Henderson Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal one three five pence (0.135d.) in the pound on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Henderson; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off; and that such special rate is hereby permanently appropriated and pledged as security for the purpose of securing the said loan of £4,700 and interest thereon at the rate of five and three eighths per cent (5 $\frac{3}{8}$ %) per annum. Further, that the Mayor and the Town Clerk be authorised to sign and issue under seal debentures, certificates, and other documents required by the lenders in respect of the said loan of £4,700."
