Authorising McCallum Brothers Ltd. to Use and Occupy a Part of the Foreshore and Bed of the Sea from Pakihi Island to Karamuramu Island in the Hauraki Gulf as a Site for a Submarine Telephone Cable

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, the Minister of Marine hereby licenses and permits McCallum Brothers Ltd. (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and bed of the sea from Pakihi Island to Karamuramu Island in the Hauraki Gulf, as shown on plan marked M.D. 11689 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining thereon a submarine telephone cable as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of December 1963.

3. The premium payable by the licensee shall be £5 and the annual sum so payable £10.
