SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that portion of Plateau Road situated in Block III, Takapau Survey District, Taupo County, commencing at its intersection with the Rotorua-Taupo County boundary, near the north-western corner of Section 34 of the aforesaid Block III, and proceeding thence in an easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 45 chains and terminating at the easternmost corner of Section 35 of the aforesaid Block III.

PURSUANT to section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the resolution passed by the Palmerston North City Council on the 16th day of December 1963, and set out in the First Schedule hereto, in so far as it affects the side and portion of street described in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE
