RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Amuri County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £4,200 authorised to be raised by the Amuri County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the Workers' Dwelling Loan 1951 which matures on 20 March 1964, the said Amuri County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.019 pence in the pound on the capital value of all rateable property of the whole of the County of Amuri; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

WANGANUI-RANGITIKEI ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric Power Board resolves:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment and repayment charges and all other expenses on the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric Power Board's Reticulation Extension Loan 1963, £100,000, to be raised pursuant to the above-mentioned authority, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one thirtieth part of one penny ($\frac{1}{30}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all the rateable property in the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric Power District; and that such special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the aforesaid loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, but not exceeding a period of 20 years."
