The Council has also resolved that the changes of the scheme shall come into effect on the 1st day of April 1964.

A copy of the change of the scheme and the scheme itself as amended by the change has been deposited in the Council's office and may be inspected, without fee, by any person who so requires at any time when the office is open to the public.
