Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 2) 1964

PURSUANT to regulation 16 of the Import Control Regulations 1964,* the Minister of Customs hereby gives notice as follows:

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 2) 1964.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 20th day of April 1964.

2. Goods of the class specified in the Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.

3. The Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 2) 1960 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS note is not part of the exemption, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Revokes exemption in *Gazette*, No. 22, of 31 March 1960, page 440, relating to "Goods, or such classes of goods, as may be approved by the Minister, etc." Wines, spirits, and wireless broadcast receiving sets are now removed from the list of goods not approved for admission in terms of the exemption.
