HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that, as from the 1st day of May 1964, the Blueskin Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 31st day of March 1954,* and the Merton Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 13th day of April 1953†, shall be united and shall form one district having the name of the Blueskin Rabbit District, the boundaries of which shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto, and further declares that the basis on which the Rabbit Board to be established for the said district shall first levy its general rate, shall be the acreage of the land occupied by the ratepayer.
