Declaring Lands in Taranaki and Hawke's Bay Land Districts Vested in the Taranaki and Hawke's Bay Education Boards as Sites for Public Schools to be Vested in Her Majesty the Oueen

> BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General By his Deputy H. E. BARROWCLOUGH A PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Taranaki Education Board, and the lands described in the Second Schedule hereto, being areas vested in the Hawke's Bay Education Board, as sites for public schools shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT

TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT PART Lot G, D.P. 4295, being part Sections 45A and 46, Fitzroy District; also part Sections 23, 59, 60, and 836 (D.P. 3266), and part Lot 1, D.P. 6025, being part Section 60, all of Grey District: Area, 5 acres 3 roods 3.3 perches, more or less.
