RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Sewerage Loan 1952, £15,800

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Opotiki Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £15,800 authorised to be raised by the Opotiki Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the Sewerage Loan 1952 which matures on the 15th day of July 1964, the said Opotiki Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal point seven five pence (0.75d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Opotiki; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Regent Street Pensioners' Flats Loan, £47,500

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 13th day of May 1964.

Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of forty-seven thousand five hundred pounds (£47,500) to be known as the Wellington City Regent Street Pensioners' Flats Loan 1964 of £47,500 authorised to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of erecting accommodation for old people, the Wellington City Council hereby makes a special rate of thirteen one-thousandths of a penny (0.013d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of thirty-five (35) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

Rural Housing Loan 1964, £10,000

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £10,000 authorised to be raised by the Golden Bay County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of making advances under the Rural Housing Act 1939, the said Golden Bay County Council hereby makes a special rate of fifteen sixty-fourths of one penny (15/64 of 1d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all rateable property of the County of Golden Bay; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
