ASHBURTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Ashburton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charge on the Fire Tender Loan 1963, of £5,000, authorised to be raised by the Ashburton Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing a fire tender, the Ashburton Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of £0.000163 in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Ashburton; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year, and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off." 2611
