PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1961; His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order:

ORDER:

1. On and from the 1st day of April 1964 the area described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the County of Waitotara and included in the City of Wanganui.

2. On and from the date aforesaid the area described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the City of Wanganui and included in the County of Waitotara.

3. The alteration of the boundaries of the said County and the said City hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act 1954.

FIRST SCHEDULE

AREA EXCLUDED FROM COUNTY OF WAITOTARA AND INCLUDED IN CITY OF WANGANUI

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, County of Waitotara, containing 1 acre and 20 perches, more or less, being part Lot 2, D.P. 744, and being also part Section 24; right bank, Wanganui River, situated in Block VI, Westmere Survey District.

SECOND SCHEDULE

AREA EXCLUDED FROM CITY OF WANGANUI AND INCLUDED IN COUNTY OF WAITOTARA

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, City of Wanganui, containing 38 perches, more or less, being part Lot 1, D.P. 16409, and being also part Section 24, right bank, Wanganui River, situated in Block VII, Westmere Survey District.
