Declaration Affecting Farming Businesses for Income Tax Purposes in Relation to a Drought

PURSUANT to section 103A of the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, the Minister of Finance hereby declares the drought in the under-mentioned localities during the autumn of 1964 and so far as it extends thereto during the winter of that last-mentioned year, to be an event, happening, or cause (within the meaning of those words as used in subsection (5) of the said section) adversely affecting farms or live-stock generally in those localities:

The following parts of the Ashburton County:

1. Shepherds Bush Survey District: Survey blocks 1 to 16 inclusive.
2. Rangitata Survey District: Survey blocks 1 to 9 inclusive.
3. Hinds Survey District: Survey blocks 1 to 16 inclusive.
4. Westerfield Survey District: Survey blocks 1 to 16 inclusive.
