PURSUANT to the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Rotorua Acclimatisation District Order 1964.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The boundaries of the Rotorua Acclimatisation District which was constituted by Order in Council on the 21st day of September 1960 are hereby altered and redefined and as from the commencement of this order, the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.
