## AMENDMENT TO RULES

These rules would now read "there shall be published in each volume of the proceedings of the Royal Society of New Zealand a complete list of awards. . "

## NEW RULES

FX Benson Fund:

1. Under the terms of his will the late Emeritus Professor William Noel Benson, B.A., D.SC., F.R.S., F.R.S.N.Z., F.G.S., F.R.G.S., a former President of the Society, who died on 20 August 1957, left one tenth of the residue of his estate to the Society "to supplement funds available for the publication of concerting papers".

2. The Benson Fund shall consist of moneys received under the will of the late Professor W. N. Benson and other funds which may be given or granted for the same purpose.
