Declaring Area Exempt From Portions of the Motor Launch Regulations 1962

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. On each bank at the edge of the river at its confluence with Lake Roxburgh and at the upstream limit of the area described in the First Schedule hereto there shall be placed two notice boards. A further one shall be placed at the site where boats are launched from. These notices shall measure not less than 2 ft 6 in. by 2 ft and shall be painted white with black latters. with black letters.

Bathers and fishermen are warned that there are no speed restrictions for launches and water skiers between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily in that area of water 6 chains up the Manuherikia River from its confluence with Lake Roxburgh.
