*Declaring Land in the North Auckland Land District, Vested in the Auckland Education Board as a Site for a Public School, to be Vested in Her Majesty the Queen*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the North Auckland Education Board as a site for a public school, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same, at the date hereof.

#### SCHEDULE

##### NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL the land on D.P. 3663 and D.P. 19186, being parts Waiarua Block, situated in Block VI, Maungaru Survey District: Total area, 1 acre 2 roods 23.5 perches, more or less. All certificates of title, Volume 137, folio 107, and Volume 446, folio 134.

*Land Set Apart as Provisional State Forest Declared to be Subject to the Land Act 1948*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto being portion of provisional State forest reserve No. 1701 set apart by Proclamation dated the 7th day of October 1930, and published in *Gazette* 9 October 1930, Volume III, page 3125, is required for settlement purposes; and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest land and shall become Crown land available for sale, lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
