Section 6 (Rural) District Scheme Approved

PURSUANT to the Town and Country Planning Regulations 1960, public notice is hereby given that the district scheme under the Town and Country Planning Act 1953, for the Rural Section (Section 6) of the Waipa County District Scheme was approved by the council by resolution passed at its meeting held on the 19th day of October 1964, after all objections, appeals, and arbitrations relating to the scheme had been disposed of and the scheme had been amended to give effect to all objections and appeals allowed, and all amendments of the district scheme required by the board had been incorporated. The council has also resolved that the scheme shall come into operation on the 2nd day of November 1964.

Copies of the scheme as approved have been deposited in the council's office, Bank Street, Te Awamutu, and may be inspected, without fee, by any person who so requires at any time when the office is open to the public.

In the matter of the Charitable Trusts Act 1957, and in the matter of a certain charitable trust declared by the will of Charles Bagley, deceased, notice is hereby given that the Public Trustee, the executor and trustee of the will of the above-named Charles Bagley deceased, has referred to the Supreme Court, at Auckland, for approval, a scheme for the disposition of capital assets and income now held by the Public Trustee on the trusts set out in the said will.
