MAXIMUM PRICES TO BE CHARGED

5. (1) The maximum factory selling prices that may be charged or received by Pacific Steel Ltd. for any steel products for which this order applies, shall be the basis price shown in this order with adjustments in the form of extras as specified hereunder being made as appropriate.

(2) The maximum prices as aforesaid are fixed for deliveries as follows:

(a) Within a radius of 25 miles of Otahuhu, free on truck at mill.
(b) At North Island ports of Whangarei, Tauranga, Napier, New Plymouth, and Wellington, and also at all South Island ports "c and f" at any such port.
