IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Otamatea County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual loan charges on a loan of £30,000 authorised to be raised by the Otamatea County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of replacing existing plant and purchasing additional plant, the said Otamatea County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal seven four five pence (0.745d.) in the pound upon the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the County of Otamatea; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on 1st April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of six years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £44,150 authorised to be raised by the Ohinemuri County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of extending and renewing the reticulation of the Ohinemuri Water Supply in the Ohinemuri County, the said Ohinemuri County Council hereby makes a special rate of 2.381d. in the £ upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Ohinemuri Water Supply Special Rating Area in the County of Ohinemuri; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and shall be payable yearly on the 7th day of September in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
