

MINING ACT 1926

APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE FOR A WATER RACE

to the Warden of the Otago Mining District, at Oamaru

PURSUANT to the Mining Act 1926, the undersigned, Robert McGimpsey, of Main Road, Kurow, farmer, hereby applies for a licence for a water race, as specified in the Schedule hereto, the course whereof has been duly marked out for the purpose.

Mark on Pegs: "A" on intake, "B" at point of return.

Precise time of marking out privilege applied for: 9 February 1965, at 2.30 p.m.

Date and number of miner's right: 9 February 1965, No. 2759.

SCHEDULE

LOCALITY of the race, and of its starting and terminal points: In County River Bed Reserve out of Kurow Creek near boundary of Sections 3 and 4, Block VIII, Kurow District, and in Reserve opposite Sections 7 and 8.

Length and intended course of race: One mile, out of County River Bed Reserve through Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7.

Points of intake: Block VIII, Kurow District and back into creek through Reserve. In County Reserve opposite boundary of Sections 3 and 4, Block VIII, Kurow District.

Estimated time and cost of construction. Race in existence, only needs repairs.

Mean depth and breadth: Depth, 1 ft. Breadth, 1 ft 6 in.

Number of heads to be diverted: One head.

Purpose for which water is to be used: Domestic and irrigation purposes.

Proposed term of licence: 21 years.

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KYEBURN RABBIT BOARD

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ORDER

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 (the consent of the Local Authorities Loans Board having been duly granted), notice is hereby given that at a special meeting of the Kyeburn Rabbit Board held on Thursday the 28th day of January 1965, the following resolution was passed to operate as a special order, and it will be submitted for confirmation at the ordinary meeting of the board to be held on Thursday, the 25th day of March 1965.

RESOLUTION

THAT, the Kyeburn Rabbit Board borrow the sum of £2,700 for a period of 20 years with interest not exceeding five and one quarter per centum per annum for the purpose of providing housing for employees of the board.

That such loan and interest charges be repaid by the board from its General Account.

That the security for such loan is to be a special rate of 0.4508 of a penny per acre over the whole rating area of the board.

That such a special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly from the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 20 years, or until such loan is fully paid off whichever is the earlier.

That no cost of raising the loan be paid out of loan moneys. That the loan be known as the Kyeburn Rabbit Board Housing Loan 1965.

If five per cent of the ratepayers of the Kyeburn Rabbit Board so demand in writing delivered or sent by post to the Secretary of Kyeburn Rabbit Board before the said 25th day of February 1965, a poll of ratepayers will be taken.
