Land in Town of Charleston Declared to be Vested in Her Majesty The Queen as Crown Land Subject to the Land Act 1948

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to section 10 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal Act 1962, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that, as from the 8th day of March 1965, the lands described in the First and Second Schedules hereto shall be deemed to be vested in Her Majesty the Queen as Crown land subject to the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
