Notice to Make Returns of Land Under the Land and Income Tax Act 1954

PURSUANT to the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, the Commissioner of Inland Revenue hereby gives notice as follows:

1. A return of land held as at noon on 31 March 1965 is required from every person and company, whether a taxpayer or not, being the owner of land in New Zealand within the meaning of the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, where total unimproved value exceeds £6,000.

2. Returns are required to be delivered or forwarded to the district office of the Taxes Division, Inland Revenue Department, where the taxpayer's records are filed, not later than 7 May 1965.

3. Return forms are available at all district offices of the Taxes Division, Inland Revenue Department, and at all permanent post offices.

4. Any person or company failing to furnish a return within the prescribed time is liable to a fine not exceeding £100 or not less than £2.
