

## TIMARU CITY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Gasworks Reconstruction Loan 1964, £30,000*

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Timaru City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charge on the loan of £30,000, to be known as the Gasworks Reconstruction Loan 1964, authorised to be raised by the Timaru City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of meeting the balance of the council's share of the cost of reconstructing the gasworks, the said Timaru City Council hereby makes a special rate of one hundred and four thousandths of a penny (0.104d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the City of Timaru; and that the said special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of 20 years, or until such loan is fully paid off."

The above resolution was passed at a meeting of the Timaru City Council held on the 22nd day of March 1965.

## BOROUGH OF PUKEKOHE

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND
