NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

NOTICE is hereby given that the Christchurch City Council proposes under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928, to take the land described in the Schedule hereto for a public work, namely, for housing reclamation purposes.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND FOR ROAD AND STOPPING OF ROAD

In the matter of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and the Public Works Act 1928, notice is hereby given that the Mount Roskill Borough Council proposes under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act to execute certain public works, namely, the diversion of Halsey Drive in the Borough of Mount Roskill, and for the purpose of such public work the lands described in the First Schedule hereto are required to be taken, and it is necessary to stop the portions of road described in the Second Schedule hereto.

Notice is further hereby given that a plan of the land so required to be taken and the road to be stopped is deposited in the public office of the Town Clerk of the said council, situated in Mount Albert Road, and is open for inspection, without fee, by all persons during ordinary office hours. Change of County of Taranaki District Scheme (Combined Area Section)
