PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excel-  
lency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice  
and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the follow-  
ing order.

## ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Taranaki Electric Power  
District Representation Order 1965.

2. This order shall come into force on the date of the  
next general election of members of local authorities.

3. The number of representatives of each constituent district  
of the Taranaki Electric Power District on the Taranaki  
Electric Power Board shall be the number specified in the  
Schedule hereto opposite the name of that constituent district.

4. The Order in Council dated the 25th day of January  
1956 and published in the *Gazette*, on the 26th day of the  
same month at page 63, reappointing representation on the  
Taranaki Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.

PURSUANT to section 5A of the Electric Power Boards Act  
1925 (as inserted by section 3 of the Electric Power Boards  
Amendment Act 1963), His Excellency the Governor-  
General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the  
Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Taranaki Electric Power  
District Boundary Order 1965.

2. The boundaries of the Taranaki Electric Power District  
are hereby altered so as to include therein the areas described  
in the Schedule hereto.

1. The Town District of Kaponga as constituted on the  
11th day of September 1922, and also those portions of the  
Eltham and Stratford Counties, as shown bordered red on the

October 1948, and outlined in blue on the plan marked

marked S.H.D. 32, deposited as aforesaid.
