## Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1965

PURSUANT to regulation 16 of the Import Control Regulations 1964,\* the Minister of Customs hereby gives notice as follows:

 (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1965.
 (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1965.
 2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the tariff items in the Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations. tions.
