

D.P. 42421; thence north-westerly along a right line between that last-mentioned point on the shores of the harbour, and a point in line with the western end of the south-eastern boundary of Section 24, Block IX, Whangarei Survey District, distant 1100 links in a south-westerly direction from the southernmost corner of the said Section 24, to a point due east of another point 1000 links due south of the south-eastern corner of Section 5, Block XIII, Whangarei Survey District; thence due west to a point due south of another point, on the north-western side of the North Auckland Railway, distant 750 links measured in a south-westerly direction along that north-western side from the north-eastern boundary of Te Rewarewa B 2; thence due north to and along the north-western side of that railway to and westerly along the generally northern boundaries of Te Rewarewa B 2 and B 1B, southerly along the western boundary of Te Rewarewa B 1A 3A, along a right line across a public road to the north-western corner of Te Rewarewa B 1A 2 and along the western boundaries of that B 1A 2 and Te Rewarewa B 1A 1 and the western and south-western boundaries of Te Rewarewa A to and up the middle of Te Waiiti Stream, to and southerly along the western side of State Highway No. 1, to and along the south-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 33086, to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 40082; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary, south-westerly along the north-western boundary of the said Lot 1, D.P. 33086, and again north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of Section 22, Block XVI, Purua Survey District, Ruarangi Block, and Section 20, Block XVI, aforesaid, to and north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 46220, Lot 4, D.P. 19724, and Lot 17, Deeds Plan 130, and along the last-mentioned boundary produced to and westerly generally up to the middle of the Raumanga Stream to a point in the said Block XVI in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 28097; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary, and that boundary produced to the north-western side of State Highway No. 14, and north-easterly generally along that north-western side to and along the eastern boundary of that part of Tokitaruna Block comprised in C.T. 766/101 (limited as to parcels), and along that boundary produced to the middle of the Te Hihhi Stream and down the middle of that stream to a point in line with the eastern boundary of part Section 8, Block XII, Purua Survey District, comprised in C.T. 68/202; thence to and along the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of that part Section 8, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary across a public road to its northern side; thence again north-easterly along the northern side of that public road forming the southern boundaries of Allotments 5 and part 4 of Pukenui 1, and part Taikawiri Block, to and along the northern side of State Highway No. 14, aforesaid; to and along the eastern boundary of part Lot 3, D.P. 17296, and along the southern boundary of part Horahora 2 comprised in C.T. 1079/28, to and along the southern and eastern boundaries of the part Horahora 2 shown on D.P. 568, to and along the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 13934, to and along the south-eastern boundary of Section 2, Block XII, Purua Survey District (Coronation Scenic Reserve), to and along a series of right lines through the said Section 2, being the generally south-eastern boundary of part Horahora 2 as shown on S.O. Plan 16342, to and along the north-eastern boundaries of that Section 2, and of Allotments S. 77 and N. 77, Whangarei Parish, along the north-eastern end of a public road, and along the north-eastern boundary of Allotment 71 of the said parish, to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Allotments 66, 67, and 68, to and along the southern boundary of Allotment 69, and its production to the middle of the Waiarohia Stream, all the aforesaid allotments being of the said Whangarei Parish; thence up the middle of the said stream to and up the middle of a tributary of that stream which flows through Lot 3, D.P. 41275, in Block VIII, Purua Survey District, to and then south-westerly along the middle of the Whau Valley Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 41275; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and then north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Lots 1, 2, and 3, D.P. 41275, and Lot 1, D.P. 38871, and along the last-mentioned boundary produced to and along the north-western boundaries of Lots 1, 2, 3, and 7 shown on Scheme Plan No. 49 lodged in the Whangarei County Office, and south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Lot 7 to the northern side of the Whau Valley Road; thence southerly along a right line to the northernmost corner of that part of Allotment 2, Whangarei Parish, comprised in C.T. 516/108 (limited as to parcels and title), and then easterly along the southern side of the Whau Valley Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 26375; thence north-westerly generally to and along that eastern boundary, along the eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 26375, and the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 26375, to and along a right line between the northernmost corner of the said Lot 1 and the southernmost corner of Lot 2, D.P. 43392, to the northern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 45066; thence along the generally northern boundary of that Lot 2, to and along the eastern and northern boundary boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 45066, and along the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 43540, to and along the south-western boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 39273, and of Lots 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, and 1, D.P. 52362, and along the last-mentioned boundary produced across Three Mile Bush Road to its northern side; thence along that side to and along the south-western boundary of that part Otapapa

Block shown on D.P. 4543, and along that boundary produced to the south-eastern boundary of Ngatapapa 2; thence again north-easterly generally along that boundary and along a right line crossing a public road to the intersection of the eastern side of that road with the middle of the Otapapa Stream, and down the middle of that stream to a point in line with the northern boundary of Lot 11, D.P. 44008; thence to and along that northern boundary, to and along the south-western boundaries of Lots 12, 13, 14, and 15, D.P. 44008, and Lot 1, D.P. 52017, the south-western and north-western boundaries of Lot 20, the north-western boundaries of Lots 29, 30, and 31, and the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 32, all of D.P. 44008, aforesaid, to and along the north-western boundary of Ngamokotuitara 2, and the production of that boundary across the Otapapa Stream to its right bank; thence along that right bank to and along the northern side of the North Auckland Railway, to and along the north-western boundary of Lot 33, D.P. 51909, to its northernmost corner; thence northerly along the south-western and north-western boundaries of that part Allotment 50, Whangarei Parish, shown on D.P. 1583, to the point of commencement.
