Declaring an Area for Use by Speedboats and Water Skiers

PURSUANT to the Motor Launch Regulations 1962, the Minister of Marine hereby declares that, for a period of two years from the date hereof, subject to compliance with the conditions set out in the Second Schedule hereto, the area of water described in the First Schedule hereto shall not be subject to regulations 11 and 12 of the Motor Launch Regulations 1962.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area of water known as the Narrows at the seaward end of Lake Forsyth generally westward of a line drawn from the easternmost point of Birdling's Flat in a 149° true direction to the opposite shore.

SECOND SCHEDULE

AT each end of the boundary line mentioned in the first Schedule hereto there shall be placed a notice board, measuring not less than 2 ft 6 in by 2 ft, painted white with

The aforesaid notice boards shall contain the following

"NOTICE

Motor Launch Regulations 1962

No speed restrictions for motor launches and water skiers westward of this notice."
