## SECURITY RATE

## Streets Loan 1965, £150,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hamilton City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds (£150,000) authorised to be raised by the Hamilton City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of improving streets, constructing bituminous footpaths, carriageways, kerbing and channelling within the city, purchasing land, and paying compensation, the said Hamilton City Council hereby makes a special rate of one hundred and ninety-four thousandths of a penny (0.194d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property within

the City of Hamilton; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

## CONSOLIDATION OF SPECIAL RATES
