"In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 35 and 36 of the Counties Act 1956 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, the Grey County Council hereby resolves by way of special order as follows:

That the Grey County Council shall consist of nine mem-bers who shall be elected by the electors of each of the North, East, and South Ridings, each electing three councillors. 2. That the built-up areas of Omoto and Kaiata and that portion of the East Riding more or less west of a line south from Camp Point, Lake Brunner, to the Taramakau River, in which is situated the settlements of Mitchells and Tara-makau, be transferred from the East Riding to the South Riding, and that the boundaries of the said South and East Ridings shall be so altered as are more particularly described in the Schedule hereto. 3. The alteration hereby made shall take effect on and after the next general election of councillors on the 9th day of

the next general election of councillors on the 9th day of October 1965, or such other date as the Minister of Internal Affairs shall decide."
