RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Papakura Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £15,000 authorised to be raised by the Papakura Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing concrete footpaths, the said Papakura Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of point eight pence in the pound (.88d. in the pound) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Papakura; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Water Supply Redemption Loan 1965, £22,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Feilding Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £22,000 authorised to be raised by the Feilding Borough Council under the provisions of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 for the purpose of repaying on maturity the Water Supply Loan 1955, £32,400, which matures on 1 November 1965, the said Feilding Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal two nought nine pence (.209d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Feilding; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
