IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby revokes the Order in Council dated 13 December 1944 and published in *Gazette*, No. 96, of 14 December 1944, at page 1504, and doth hereby declare that the Westland Catchment Board shall consist of 10 elective members and five non-elective members, and that the number of such elective members to be representative of each separate constituent district or combined district within the catchment district on the said Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of the constituent district or group of names of constituent districts comprising a combined district; and doth further declare that each group of constituent districts, the names of which are bracketed together in the first column of the Schedule hereto, is hereby constituted a combined district for the purposes of the said Act, and that the principal local authority of each such combined district shall be the local authority of the constituent district distinguished in the first column of the Schedule hereto by the letter "(P)".
