

maunu Maori Block; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of the said part Section 3c 2 of 2, part Sections 3b of 2, 3a of 2, and 4a of 2 to the middle line of the Ohau Stream in Block XV, Kaitarau Survey District; thence generally southerly along the middle line of the said stream to the mean high-water mark of the sea; thence generally south-westerly along the mean high-water mark of the sea to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom that area of land bounded by a line commencing at Triangulation Station Manakau, in Block XIII, Kaitarau Survey District, and proceeding generally south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of Run 205 to the triangulation station known as Snowflake in Block IX, Greenburn Survey District; thence on a bearing of 145° true for a distance of 20 chains; thence on a bearing of 227° true for a distance of three chains; thence on a bearing of 154° true for a distance of approximately 247 chains to the middle line of the Kowhai River in Block XIII, Mount Fyffe Survey District; thence generally south-westerly and south-easterly along the middle line of the said Kowhai River to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 53, Kincaid Run, Kaikoura Registration District, in Block XIII, aforesaid; thence north-easterly to and along the said boundary to the northernmost point of the said Section 53; thence generally easterly along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 53, the eastern boundary of Section 54, the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 55, and the northern boundaries of Sections 56, 60, and 61, all of Kincaid Run, Kaikoura Registration District, to the western side of a public road; thence northerly along the western side of the said road to the south-western corner of Section 9, Block IV, Mount Fyffe Survey District; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said Section 9 and its production to the left bank of the Waimangarara River; thence southerly along the said left bank for a distance of approximately 10 chains to the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 9; thence generally northerly along the south-eastern and eastern boundaries of the said Section 9 to the southern boundary of Section 5, Block I, Mount Fyffe Survey District; thence easterly and north-easterly along the southern and south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 5 and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle line of Long Creek; thence generally easterly and south-easterly along the middle line of Long Creek to the middle line of the Hapuku River; thence generally north-westerly along the middle line of the said Hapuku River to its junction with the middle line of the stream forming the southern boundary of S.G.R. 102b in Block XIV, Kaitarau Survey District; thence generally south-westerly along the said middle line to a point in line with the south-western boundary of the said S.G.R. 102b; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and northerly along the western boundary of the said S.G.R. 102b to Triangulation Station Manakau; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked N.Z.E.D. 685, deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington, and thereon outlined in red.

The Thames Borough Council Water Power and Electric Lines Licence 1965

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of August 1965

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Thames Borough Council Water Power and Electric Lines Licence 1965.

2. Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the Thames Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as the licensee) is hereby granted a licence to take and use from the Thames Borough water supplies and reservoirs in the South Auckland Land District, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a stream of water and also to lay, construct, put up, place, and use the electric lines described in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.

4. This licence is issued under the Water Power Regulations 1934, and is subject thereto, and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, the Radio Interference Regulations 1958, and to all regulations made in amendment thereof or in substitution thereof, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence. Provided that the licensee shall not by virtue of this clause be required, except in the course of alteration, repair, or maintenance, to reconstruct in conformity with the regulations hereinbefore mentioned any electric lines or works which conformed to the regulations in force at the time of the construction thereof.

5. The water shall be taken from the 30 in. water main from the Thames Borough water supply near the junction of Bella Street and Waiokaraka Road in the Borough of Thames at a point marked on the plan marked N.Z.E.D. 662 deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington. The water shall be used solely for the purpose of generating electricity.

6. The licensee is hereby authorised, subject to the conditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the works described in the Second Schedule hereto, the position of the said works being indicated on the said plan N.Z.E.D. 662.

7. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), and (f) of regulation 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.

8. Nothing in this licence shall of itself be deemed to confer upon the licensee any right to water.

9. This licence shall, unless sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 31st day of March 1986.

10. The Orders in Council specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

LINES and works for the supply of electrical energy within the Borough of Thames, as constituted on the 26th day of January 1921, as outlined by a dotted red line on the said plan N.Z.E.D. 662.

SECOND SCHEDULE

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF GENERATING WORKS

(a) Pipeline leading from the said water supply reservoir to the powerhouse hereinafter referred to.

(b) Powerhouse with water turbines, generators, and all necessary equipment for generating electricity having a maximum capacity of 122 kilovolt-amperes.

(c) Tail race from the powerhouse aforesaid to the Firth of Thames.

All as indicated on the said plan N.Z.E.D. 662.
