"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £72,000 authorised to be raised by the Whangarei Harbour Board under the above-mentioned Act, and in terms of the Whangarei Harbour Board Vesting and Empowering Act 1950, for harbour improvement works at Whangarei, the said Whangarei Harbour Board hereby makes a special rate of one-sixth of one penny in the £1 (3ed.) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Whangarei Harbour District, comprising the Borough of Whangarei, the Town Districts of Kamo and Hikurangi, and the County of Whangarei, excepting out of such county that portion thereof comprised in the Waipu River District as defined in Proclamation published in the Gazette on the 1st day of March 1900; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was passed at the ordinary monthly meeting of the Whangarei Harbour Board held on the 10th day of September 1964.
