NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

IN the matter of the Public Works Act 1928 and the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, notice is hereby given that the Auckland Regional Authority proposes under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts to take the land in the Schedule hereto for a regional reserve.

And notice is hereby further given that a plan of the lands so required to be taken is deposited at the office of the Auckland Regional Authority, at Rexall House, at the corner of Customs Street West, and Albert Street, Auckland and is open for inspection without fee, by all persons during ordinary office hours.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Sewerage Renewal Loan 1965, £39,300

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Whakatane Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the annual charges on a loan of thirty-nine thousand three hundred pounds (£39,300) authorised to be raised by the Whakatane Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purposes of repaying on maturity those portions of the Sewerage Loan 1954, £162,000 which mature on 1 August and 1 October 1965, the said Whakatane Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal point three three pence (0.33d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the Borough of Whakatane; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

AUCKLAND CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Administration Building Additional Loan No. 2, 1963, £245,000

THAT in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and amendments, the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and amendment, and regulations thereunder, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of two hundred and forty-five thousand pounds (£245,000) to be known as the Administration Building Additional Loan No. 2, 1963, £245,000 which amount is proposed to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of meeting part of the cost of erecting the City Administration Building and the cost of raising the loan, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of four-thirteenths of one penny (¼¹³ths of 1d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property of Auckland City comprising the whole of the City of Auckland; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the said loan or until the loan is fully paid off."
