SPECIAL ORDER

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by section 16 of the Land Drainage Act 1908 and section 2 of the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1920, the Board at a special meeting held in the Hauraki Plains County Council Chambers at Ngatea at 10 a.m. on the 25th day of May 1965 resolved as follows:

“That, in pursuance and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Land Drainage Act 1908 and the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1920 and all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Board of Trustees of the Hauraki South Drainage District hereby resolves by way of special order to alter the subdivisions within the district, and also to alter the representation of the various subdivisions. The altered subdivisions are detailed below and the Eastern Subdivision shall be entitled to two trustees, the Central Subdivision shall be entitled to one trustee, the Awaiti Subdivision shall be entitled to two trustees and the Western Subdivision shall be entitled to two trustees.”

This special order shall come into effect on 9 October 1965 except in so far as it is necessary to provide for the triennial election of trustees which is to be held on that day.

SCHEDULE

EASTERN SUBDIVISION

*Two Trustees*

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Hauraki Plains, and Piako Counties, bounded by a line commencing at the junction of the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 11081, produced to meet the left bank of the Waihou River in Block XI, Waihou Survey District, and proceeding easterly and generally southerly along that left bank and the left bank of the Ngahina Canal, to and again along the left bank of the Wihou River to the north-eastern corner of Awaiti 1H 2A 3 in Block IV, Waitoa Survey District; thence generally westerly along the generally northern boundaries of the said 1H 2A 3 to the westernmost corner of Awaiti 1H 2B 1; thence northerly along a right line to and along the eastern boundary of Section 18, Block XV, Waihou Survey District, and along another right line being the last-mentioned boundary produced across Awaiti South Road, to and along its eastern side to the north-western corner of part Awaiti 1J 2B 2B; thence south-westerly along a right line to the northernmost corner of an unnamed roadline; thence generally northerly along the generally western side of the said road, to the south-eastern corner of Section 3, Block XV, Waihou Survey District; thence easterly along a right line across the said road, to and along the southern boundary of Section 7 of the said Block XV, to and northerly along the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 12874, to and along a right line across Pukahu Road, to and along the western boundaries of Lots 7 and part 6, D.P. 13147, Lot 2, D.P. 10934, and the last-named boundary produced across State Highway No. 2, to and north-westerly along the north-eastern side of the said highway, to and north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, D.P. 4617, and part Ahipukahu No. 1, to and along a right line across School Road to the south-eastern corner of Lot 2, D.P. 11081, situated in Block XII, Waihou Survey District; thence westerly and north-westerly along the southern and south-western boundaries of that Lot 2 and the last-named boundary produced to the point of commencement.

CENTRAL SUBDIVISION

*One Trustee*

All that area in the South Auckland Land District, Hauraki Plains County, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the left bank of the Waihou River with the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 5103, situated in Block VII, Waihou Survey District, and proceeding generally southerly along that left bank, to and again southerly along the western boundary of the Eastern Subdivision, as hereinbefore described, to the south-eastern corner of Section 3, Block XV, of the aforesaid survey district; thence westerly along the southern boundary of the said Section 3, to and north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Section 3 aforesaid, and part Section 1, Block XV aforesaid, to and north-westerly along a right line across Pukahu Road to the southernmost corner of Section 32, Block XI, Waihou Survey District; thence easterly along the northern side of Pukahu Road, to and north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of part Section 33 and Section 31, Block XI aforesaid, to and north-easterly along the south-eastern side of Awaiti West Road, to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Section 26, Block XI aforesaid; thence north-westerly along a right line to and along that north-eastern boundary to and north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Section 25, Block XI aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of that section; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 58 and 57, Block XI aforesaid, to and westerly along the northern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 11655, to the eastern side of Fisher's Road; thence northerly and generally north-easterly along the eastern and generally south-eastern sides of that road, crossing the intervening School Road, to the intersection of that last-mentioned south-eastern roadside with the generally western side of State Highway No. 2; thence north-easterly along a right line to
