Altering the Boundaries of the Hauraki United Drainage District and the Hauraki South Drainage District

IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 and the Land Drainage Act 1908, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, alters the boundaries of the Hauraki United Drainage District and the Hauraki South Drainage District by excluding the land described in the Schedule hereto from the Hauraki United Drainage District and including the said land in the Hauraki South Drainage District.

SCHEDULE

LAND to be excluded from Hauraki United Drainage District and included in the Hauraki South Drainage District:

All that area in the South Auckland Land District, Hauraki Plains County, bounded by a line commencing at the western-most corner of Section 70, Block VI, Waihou Survey District, and proceeding generally north-westerly along the generally north-eastern boundary of Section 69, Block VI, aforesaid, to and generally north-easterly along the generally south-eastern side of a public road, and that last-mentioned roadside produced across another public road, to and north-westerly along the north-eastern side of the public road, to and generally easterly along the generally southern side of the Karepehi-Turua road, to and generally south-easterly along the generally south-western side of State Highway No. 2, crossing the intervening Kaikahu Road, to and generally north-westerly along the generally south-western side of Kaikahu Road, to and south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of part Makumaku 3B Block and Section 70, aforesaid, to the point of commencement.
