## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928 and the Electric  
Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General,  
acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive  
Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Ashburton Electric Power  
and Gas Board Electric Lines Licence 1965.

2. Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the Ash-  
burton Electric Power and Gas Board (hereinafter referred to  
as the licensee) is hereby authorised to lay, construct, put up,  
place, and use electric lines, and to construct electric works  
which may from time to time be required for the distribution  
and supply of electricity within the area of supply described in  
the Schedule hereto.

3. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by  
the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical  
Wiring Regulations 1961 shall be incorporated herein and  
shall form part of this licence, except in so far as they may  
be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.

4. The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by  
the licensee with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the  
Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, the Radio Interference  
Regulations 1958, and with all regulations made in amendment  
thereof or in substitution therefor, except in so far as they  
may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.

5. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs  
(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), and (h) of regulation 21-01 of  
the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.

6. This licence shall, unless it is sooner lawfully determined,  
continue in force until the 31st day of March 1986.

7. The Order in Council, dated the 4th day of February  
1959 and published in the *Gazette* on the 19th day of the  
same month at page 168, authorising the licensee to use  
electric lines, is hereby revoked.
